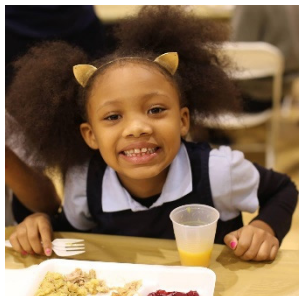

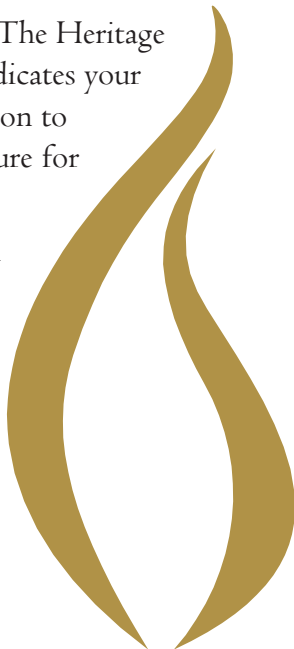
## What is The Heritage Club?
